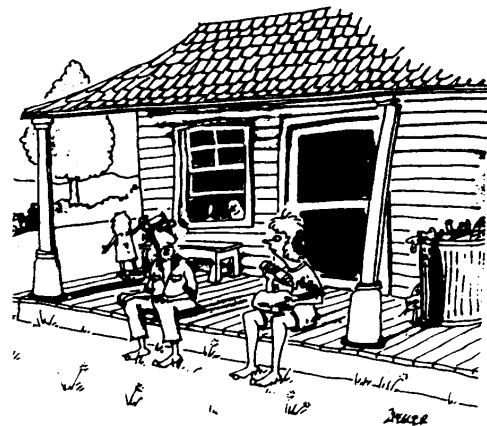
PONDERINGS DEP'T

AMA District IX Meeting

The meeting of District IX clubs in Colorado took place on December 20 at the board room of the Wings Over the Rockies museum. The meeting was hosted by Colorado AVP Tom Neff and was chaired by our AMA VP Jim Tiller. Rick and I represented the MMM Club. It does seem somewhat overwhelming in that Free Flight is on the minority of the AMA membership and attendees at the meeting, but we were not intimidated(!)

Each club in attendance made short presentations as to their current status and any issues they are facing. Our fellow Lowry range club, Cross Winds RC was not present. There were a number of "new" clubs that were sort of disassociated with District 9 and attended to make their voice heard. This is good news as it does show there are many modelers out there that need a place to be recognized.

There is a club in Canyon City and their rep did not know anything about Jim Martin, the FOX Engine person.

When it came time for us to present, Rick went first and described the club in general terms, explaining what is free flight and pointed them toward our web site. VP Jim Tiller said he was delighted to be receiving our newsletter and is looking forward to learning more about us. Rick mentioned he did the newsletter for over 30 years and got a round of applause. He also made a pitch to encourage those RC folks to take a look at FF and what it has to offer. Many of the RC reps there told stories of how discouraging some of the venues were and they had trouble flying. I followed Rick with a discussion of our three championship events, Pikes Peak Ceiling Climb, 14 Round World Cup FAI Contest and the Rocky Mountain Free Flight Champs. I also briefed them on our proposal to have the

2015 indoor nationals in Colorado Springs. Jim Tiller said he would support this proposal at the Executive Council level.

There was a long discussion of drones ala the new FAA proposals and the amount of effort the AMA has put into it, both resource and money. Most in the room see drones as a major threat to the RC hobby as local governments and people in general don't see the difference between drones and RC models. One club reported that neighbors are very concerned and are putting pressure on the land owner to have them evicted.

On a more positive note there was a discussion of juniors and we told the meeting about Jace. Jim wants to run a story about him in his Model Aviation column.

We have entered our schedule into the District IX web site.

As we were leaving it was clear to me that the MMM Club is in very good shape and we are being seen in a very positive light by Jim and his staff. Rick was impressed in the number of attendees that seemed genuinely interested about FF as another avenue. In particular is an RC Electric club which has some real talent in that area.
