

The MMM Indoor Scramble (IDS)

1. The Object--to create a season-long (or annual) contest permitting competitors to compete head to head, regardless of class of model.
2. Eligible classes are those AMA or FAC classes for which there is an established Colorado Springs City Auditorium record. (See the top of the Score Sheet)
3. The Day's Contest:
 - a) Rubber: Contestants fly up to 5 official flights for each class chosen. Each flight's score equals the percent of City Aud Record attained. Example: The LPP City Aud record is 10:15, so a 4:45 LPP flight scores as $285/615 = .4634$, or 46% .

Flight times are truncated to the next lowest second (or tenth of a second for glider).
Calculated Flight Scores are truncated to the next lowest hundredth (or "whole point")

In practice, only the best flight need be scored.

- b) An Attempt is 10 seconds. Re-fly with no consequence if flight is shorter.
 - c) There is no limit to the number of classes a flyer may fly. If you don't like the way your A6 is flying, you can jump to P-18, or Dime Scale, or HLG, or...
 - d) Glider: Same story, but 10 official flights are permitted.
 - e) Winner for the day is the flier with the highest single flight score.
4. The year-long contest ("Scramble Points")

For a day's contest:

1st = 100 points

2nd = 80

3rd = 70

4th = 60

5th = 50

High total for the season wins! (And the prize shall be...a warm handshake?)
